

## Stationary

- 1 pencil case
- 5 regular HB writing pencils
- 1 set of 12 colored pencils
- 2 large glue sticks

- 3 highlighter pens (yellow, green, blue)

## BYOD (G8-12) – Laptop minimum specifications:

- At least 6-8 hour battery life – more is better
- Operating system Mac OS X, Windows 7 or later (No Chrome OS or Windows RT, or Linux)
- Screen size greater than 10 inches (in Germany screen size is phrased as "Zoll" which is equivalent to inches using the same abbreviation, e.g. 10")
- Able to connect to Wi-Fi
- Able to be ready for use in under a minute from startup or standby
- Light enough to carry back and forth from school and between classes
