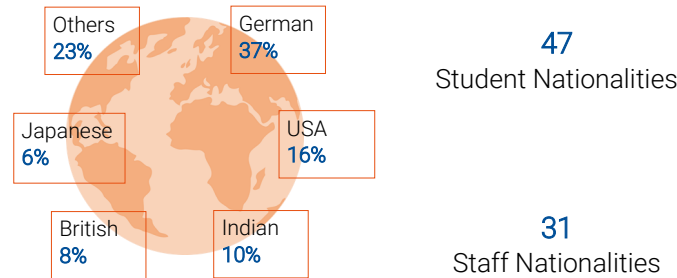

- 5 additional credits of the student's choice

Successful completion of the CAS programme and continuous participation in Physical Education are required for graduation. Students must attend school at least 85% of each school year to be eligible for a credit.
