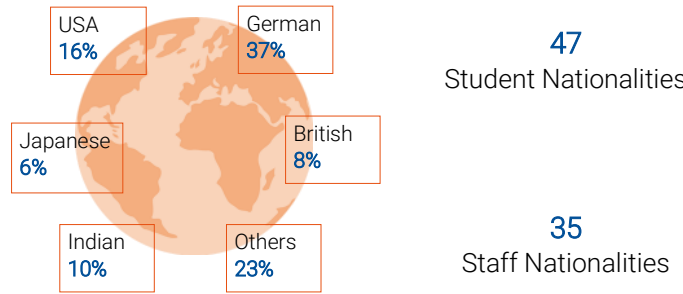
The FIS conforms to the International Baccalaureate system with marks ranging from 7 (highest) to 1 (lowest). This marking system is used for all internal and external assessments.
